Curtorim Wetlands: Fact Sheet

Location: About 6 kilometres east of Margao city in Salcette Taluka

Habitat Description: Wetland habitat formed of active cultivations well serviced by systems of dams and bunds which provide water and food for the birds. Habitat is healthy with no serious threat anticipated for the birds in the years to come.

Tips: This is the largest amongst all hot spots featured here. And, it's possible there are more undiscovered hot spots and waiting to be explored by you!

Star Species: All wetland birds including rare birds like the Brown Crake which has been spotted on the Shiroda embankments. Other rare birds recorded in this area include the White Stork, the Lesser Adjutant Stork, the White-bellied Sea Eagle and the Knob-billed Duck. The entire habitat is well spread out and would require a week to completely explore this zone.
