Salvador do Mundo Wetlands: Fact Sheet

Location: About 4 kilometres from Panjim across Mandovi River

Habitat Description: Habitat is a tidal salt water artificially created through erection of bunds for the purpose of fishing by trapping the fish through tidal sluice gates. The collateral effect has been such that, mangroves have grown along the bunds providing habitats for many birds including the rare Collared Kingfisher and other kingfishers, cormorants, raptors and waders. The grasses along the bunds also throw up many unsual birds such as the prinia and stonechats.

Tips: The best time to visit the zone is early mornings and at sunset.
