

Verna Plateau: Fact Sheet

<u>Location:</u> About 2 kilometres from Verna Industrial Estate eastwards.

<u>Habitat Description:</u> Habitat is rocky grassland surrounded with forested slopes. The area is under severe threat from expansion of the industrial estate, increasing traffic volume and a new highway from Verna junction through Loutolim slopes towards Borim bridge without any mitigation measures to protect the rich wildlife.

<u>Tips:</u> The best time to visit the area is early mornings before o800 hours and late evening after 2100 hours.

Star Species: The habitat throws up interesting sightings—year after year giving the indication that it serves as an important stopover and a flyway junction for migrating birds. There are exotic sightings of Rock Eagle Owl, Short-eared Owl, European Roller, Amur Falcon, Common Cuckoo, Nilgiri Wood Pigeon, Great Hornbills, Rufous-tailed Larks, etc. Other mammals spotted are leopards, langurs, porcupines, jungle cat, black-naped hare and reptiles such as Whitakers Boa, Saw-scaled vipers etc.
